



I hope you break them if you already do.


I hope everyone who touches you has the softest, gentlest hands.

I hope the only thing you're ever hungry for is more life.




I hope you never sit next to someone in a movie who tells you what's about to happen before it happens.

I hope you find something unexplainable on the side of a road, like it was left there just for you.


I hope you experience a moment of truth and beauty that inspires you for years and sets your eyes on fire, and that everyone who looks at you after that moment knows that you have changed.


I hope nothing you ever search for on a web browser comes back to haunt you.

I hope you never struggle to find a toothpick when you need one.


I hope people get you blank books for Christmas every year because you're always filling them with ideas.

I hope squirrels cheer you on, as you go.


