4C The Lazy Email Generator

Activity type: Reading and writing - Writing an email - Pairs / Individuals

Aim: To practise giving news in an email

Language: Write a personal email giving news - Use at any point from Explore Writing, p40.

Preparation: Make two copies of the worksheet for each learner.

Time: 20-30 minutes

- Ask learners if they have busy lives and find it hard to keep in touch with old friends, hopefully getting the response that they do! Explain that the *Lazy Email Generator* can help them.
- 2 Give one copy of the worksheet to each learner. Ask them to read the email and then tell you about the writer's news. Then they work in pairs to put phrases a–j in the correct spaces 1–10 in the email. If necessary, use the first space as an example, showing that learners need to find a phrase which describes how they are: **b** *OK*.

1b 2a 3i 4c 5f 6g 7j 8e 9d 10h

- Give each learner the name of another learner in the class, but tell them not to reveal the name they are given. They then write an email to that learner, imagining that he/she is an old friend. Learners use the email structure and layout provided by the *Lazy Email Generator* to help them to write an email to their 'old friend', giving them their news. If necessary, give learners a second copy of the worksheet to write on.
- 4 Collect the finished emails and distribute them to their recipients. Learners read the email they have received and to try to guess who it is from.

Extension

Finished emails can be posted on the walls of the classroom for everyone to read before voting for the most interesting one.
